I'm glad your liking SolidWorks! Unfortunately the length for the Entrepreneur program is just for 1 year. SolidWorks does offer term licensing where you can rent the license for 3 months or 1 year in length. The cost is cheaper.

The cost for SolidWorks standard 3 months is \$810 and a year is \$2700. Besides the term license the only other option would be to finance getting a license.
